Subject: **Clarification on Company Constitution and Holding Activities**

Dear Sirs,

We are writing to provide clarification regarding the constitutional capacity of our company under Irish law, specifically in relation to its ability to carry on holding activities.

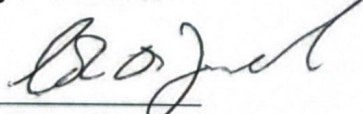
Under the Companies Act 2014, Private Company Limited by Shares (LTD) has **unrestricted capacity**. This means that the company is legally permitted to engage in any lawful activity, including acquiring, holding, managing, and disposing of shares, subsidiaries, and other investments.

Importantly, **Irish law does not require the company's constitution to explicitly include the word "holding"** in order to engage in such activities. The absence of this specific term in the company's constitution does not limit or affect its legal capacity to carry out holding activities.

Accordingly, we confirm that the **existing constitution of the company is fully in line with applicable Irish laws and regulations**. There is therefore **no legal obligation** for the company, as an Irish entity, to amend its constitution to include the word "holding."
