Term of Appointment

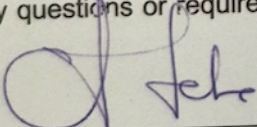
Your appointment as Compliance Officer shall take effect immediately and shall continue until such time as the Board determines otherwise or until resignation or removal from office.

Authority

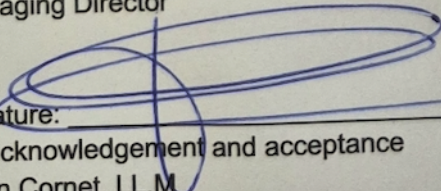
