Entity information

General notes

The most important activities of the entity

Silverttech N.V. is a limited liability company that was incorporated in Willemstad on November 10, 2023. The Company is registered with the Chamber of Commerce and Industry of Curaçao under number 165464.

The Company is solely engaged in e-gaming activities.

General accounting principles

The accounting standards used to prepare the financial statements

The accompanying annual accounts have been prepared in accordance with Book 2 of the Curaçao Civil Code using the guidelines for annual reporting of the Dutch Accounting Standards Board.

Assets and liabilities are stated at face value unless indicated otherwise.

Disclosure of changes in accounting policies

The principles of valuation and determination of result remained unchanged compared to the previous year.

Accounting principles

Current assets

Current assets are initially valued at the fair value of the consideration to be received. Trade receivables are subsequently valued at the amortised cost price. If payment of the receivable is postponed under an extended payment deadline, fair value is measured on the basis of the discounted value of the expected revenues. Interest gains are recognised using the effective interest method. Provisions for bad debts are deducted from the carrying amount of the receivable.

Current liabilities

On initial recognition current liabilities are recognised at fair value. After initial recognition current liabilities are recognised at the amortised cost price, being the amount received taking into account premiums or discounts and minus transaction costs. This is usually the nominal value.

Accounting principles for determining the result

The result is the difference between the realisable value of the goods/services provided and the costs and other charges during the year. The results on transactions are recognised in the year in which they are realised..

General and administrative expenses

General and administrative expenses comprise costs chargeable to the year that are not directly attributable to the cost of the goods and services sold.
