

The purpose of the following list is to identify countries that pose risks in terms of security, compliance, or other legal and regulatory concerns.

We are prohibited to conduct business transactions or engage in trade activities of the following list of prohibited countries.

**Prohibited Country List:**

- **China**

The FATF identifies the following High-Risk Jurisdictions subject to a Call for Action (i.e. "black list")

- **Democratic People's Republic of Korea (North Korea):** Due to ongoing political tensions and sanctions imposed by the international community, any business dealings with North Korea are prohibited.
- **Iran:** Sanctions imposed on Iran limit business opportunities and transactions with the country.
- **Myanmar:** Human rights abuses and political unrest in Myanmar may present risks for businesses operating in the country.

The following countries are currently under the United Nations Security Council (UNSC) sanctions:

- **Central African Republic**
- **Democratic Republic of Congo**
- **Eritrea**
- **Guinea-Bissau**
- **Iraq**
- **Lebanon**
- **Libya**
- **Mali**
- **Somalia**
- **South Sudan**
- **Sudan**
- **Yemen.**

It is imperative for the Company to be aware of the prohibited country list and comply with international regulations when conducting business transactions.

We have to ensure that the operations are conducted responsibly and ethically. Failure to adhere to the prohibited country list may result in legal consequences and reputational damage for the Company.
