

F12 Gaming N.V. – Crypto Risk Management Policy

This Crypto Risk Management Policy (“Policy”) outlines the principles and practices adopted by **F12 Gaming N.V.**, a company licensed and regulated by the Curaçao Gaming Authority (CGA) under the National Ordinance on Games of Chance (LOK), regarding the use, acceptance, and management of cryptocurrencies within its gaming operations.

1. Purpose

The purpose of this Policy is to ensure that all cryptocurrency transactions conducted by players and **F12 Gaming N.V.** are managed in a secure, transparent, and compliant manner, consistent with applicable laws, CGA requirements, and international standards for Anti-Money Laundering (AML) and Countering the Financing of Terrorism (CFT).

2. Scope

This Policy applies to all users who deposit, wager, or withdraw funds using cryptocurrencies on **F12 Gaming N.V.’s** platform, **F12.bet**, as well as to **F12 Gaming N.V.’s** internal handling of such assets.

3. Compliance Commitment

F12 Gaming N.V. complies with the LOK legislation, CGA directives, and international regulatory standards including those set by the Financial Action Task Force (FATF). **F12 Gaming N.V.** implements robust KYC (Know Your Customer) and source-of-funds verification processes for all crypto users.

4. Key Principles

- **KYC & Source of Funds Verification** – All players must verify their identity and the origin of funds prior to engaging in cryptocurrency transactions.
- **Transparency** – All crypto-to-fiat conversions are traceable and conducted through approved providers.
- **Transaction Monitoring** – All crypto transactions are screened for suspicious activity, using blockchain analysis tools when necessary.
- **Security** – Wallets are maintained using advanced security controls, including encryption and cold storage.
- **Fair Play** – Crypto usage is monitored to prevent fraud, collusion, or manipulation.

5. Disclaimer

F12 Gaming N.V. reserves the right to delay, restrict, or refuse cryptocurrency transactions that raise compliance or security concerns. Players are reminded that all crypto transactions are subject to verification and review under the LOK and CGA regulations.
