For Business -to- Business ("B2B") verification purposes, a License Verification Certificate ("LVC") is required.

IMPORTANT LICENSE INFORMATION -

The trade name "Curaçao eGaming" or "CEG" is owned by Cyberluck Curaçao N.V. ("Cyberluck"), a public limited company, incorporated on March 15th, 1996 in Curaçao. Cyberluck is licensed by the Government of Curaçao since October 1st, 1996 under license reference 1668/JAZ to offer games of chance, including the right to under regulatory obligations grant the said offering to third party IP-operators, commonly known as "sublicensing". The Public License Certificate is a bespoke, public certificate, listing the information of one single domain and its Alternate Designations ("AD's") for compliance purposes. It is valid for public display within the "Heartbeat" section on the said domain and its ADs only and cannot be used for any purposes of certification, other than to provide assurance to players ("End Users") that the website is under compliance oversight by CEG. To safeguard that certified operations have remained legitimate, this certificate expires and needs to be renewed on a quarterly basis. For Business-to- Business ("B2B") certification purposes, an additional, License Verification Certificate ("LVC") is required. The certificate does not allow in any way the holder to authorize other parties to offer games of chance, commonly known as "white labeling". Any abuse of the certificate shall lead to a criminal complaint by CEG, filed in all relevant jurisdictions. CEG under no circumstance grants licenses that have not been approved by the board of directors by the licensed IP-Operator. By law, only locally formed companies (B.V. or N.V.) may hold a (sub)license. No Curaçao entity may operate under a foreign license. Only CEG may grant authority to offer games of chance under its sublicense. CEG may at any time revoke sublicenses. The Public License Certificate is only displayed on the "Heartbeat" Seal. A digital or hard copy is not deemed valid. For fraud prevention purposes, no digital third party validation systems are allowed. Additional Terms For Self-Exclusion

The option to Self-Exclude ("Self-Exclusion") via the verification page (the: "Seal") is an intermediary service of Curaçao eGaming ("CEG"). By submitting a request for Self-Exclusion (the "Request") via the Self-Exclusion form (the "Form"), the end user ("End-User") triggers a mandatory procedure for the operator (the "Operator") of this particular to discontinue services to the End-User for a minimum of 6 (six) months as per the IP-Agreement between CEG and the Operator. The Request shall not immediately trigger Self-Exclusion. CEG shall first confirm the identity of the End-User. Once the request is properly validated, the Operator shall be allowed a grace period of seven calendar days to comply with the Request, after which the Operator should confirm the Self-Exclusion to the End-User. The End-User is at any time allowed to seek alternate means to Self-Exclude. However CEG does not accept any responsibility for the End-User that opts not to follow this particular intermediary procedure.
