DIRECT DEBIT GUARANTEE

Why not set up a Council Tax online account?

Manage your account online and apply for paperless billing at www.milton-keynes.gov.uk/council-tax-online

- This Guarantee is offered by all banks and building societies that accept instructions to pay Direct Debits.
- If there are any changes to the amount, date or frequency of your Direct Debit, Milton Keynes City Council will notify you 10 working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed. If you request Milton Keynes City Council to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request.
- If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit by Milton Keynes City Council or your bank or building society you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society. If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when Milton Keynes City Council asks you to.
- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your bank or building society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify us.

**You have chosen to pay by Direct Debit and payments will only be requested for the amounts shown on this notice.
You are not required to cancel your Direct Debit at the end of the financial year.**

If you want to pay in 12 monthly instalments instead of 10, contact us at counciltax@milton-keynes.gov.uk by 15 April. Requests after this date will have instalments calculated over the remaining months of the year.

Council Tax Reduction (CTR)

If you have a low income or receive certain government benefits, you might qualify for a reduced bill. Check your eligibility and apply at www.milton-keynes.gov.uk/benefits. Delaying your application will reduce your entitlement.

You must inform us of any changes in your circumstances that could affect your Council Tax Reduction (CTR), such as changes in household income, savings, or if someone moves in or out. Report changes at www.milton-keynes.gov.uk/benefits. Failure to notify us of changes affecting your CTR entitlement could result in prosecution.

Details of your CTR calculation are available on your online Council Tax account. Register or log in at www.milton-keynes.gov.uk/council-tax-online. To request a copy of the calculation, an explanation of your CTR award, or to appeal a CTR decision, contact us in writing or email benefits@milton-keynes.gov.uk. Appeals must be made within one month of receiving your new bill showing your award.

Discounts, Exemptions and Premiums

In certain circumstances you may be eligible for discount or exemption in your Council Tax, for example if you live alone, if you are a student, if you have moved to receive care or if you are disabled and have certain features in your property because of your disability. If you have a second home or a long-term empty property you may have a premium added to your Council Tax. Visit www.milton-keynes.gov.uk/council-tax/discounts-exemptions-and-premiums for more information and details of how to apply.

You must inform us within 21 days if you are not entitled to any discount or exemption shown on the bill or if there is a change in circumstance that may affect the amount of any discount, exemption or premium shown. If you fail to do so you may have to pay a penalty.

Valuation Bands

Every property is assigned one of eight Council Tax bands (A to H) by the Valuation Office Agency, based on its market value as of April 1, 1991. For more information on how your property is banded, visit www.gov.uk/guidance/understand-how-council-tax-bands-are-assessed.

Appeals

You can appeal if you believe you are not responsible for Council Tax, your property should be exempt, or Milton Keynes City Council has calculated your bill incorrectly. Submit your appeal in writing to counciltax@milton-keynes.gov.uk within two months of the initial decision. If you disagree with the outcome, you can appeal to the Valuation Tribunal within another two months. More info: www.valuationtribunal.gov.uk.

If you think your property's Council Tax band is incorrect, you can appeal to the Valuation Office Agency. You can request a review if you've been the taxpayer for less than six months or if your band changed in the last six months. Otherwise, you'll need strong evidence to support your claim. Check and challenge your Council Tax band at www.gov.uk/challenge-council-tax-band.

Sharing Information

Milton Keynes City Council takes part in the National Fraud Initiative (NFI), which matches electronic data between public and private sector bodies to prevent and detect fraud. This means Council Tax data will be shared with the Government for comparison across different systems and authorities. We inform Council Tax payers that their data will be used for this purpose.
